WEATHER REPORT THE VINEYARD Autumn with good rains. Important anticyclone between late December and mid-January, with abundant fogs and night frosts. Gloria storm passed the week of January 20, with some damage. Dry February and very rainy spring. Dry summer without significant rains. The vine begins to sprout between the second and third week of March. At the beginning of April the whole vine is already sprouted. Between May 15 and May 30 the vineyard flowers and by mid-June the grapes are already pea-sized. Veraison at the end of July. We start the harvest on August 18. An abundant total rain of 702 liters. Rainy and humid year with mildew affectations that fortunately we were able to control. Organic and dry farming.

GRAPE VARIETY Garnatxa Blanca (White Grenache) planted in the 1990s.

HARVEST DATE 20 th august 2020. Manual Harvest

WINEMAKING PROCESS We have gone back to using an ancient winemaking technique which was once common in the Terra Alta wine region: White wines with skin contact. In other words, we are making a white wine as if it were a red wine. Fermentation with indigenous yeast. We keep the skins, pulp and seeds in during fermentation for ten days. The fermentation ends in ceramic deposits of 740 liters of capacity. Subsequent aging in the same deposit, with fine lees, for 9 months.
