CLIMATOLOGY: The vineyard has grown with great vigor and has recovered from the great drought suffered in 2024. At the end of May the landscape of Terra Alta was an intense green color. We have had a lot of work to control the growth of the weeds. After that, the month of June has been one of the warmest Junes we can remember. Historically hot end of June and beginning of July. On July 12, almost 80 liters fell accompanied by hail, severely affecting grapes and leaves especially in the vineyards of Senia and Coll de Joaquin. Very humid autumn, especially from the beginning of October to the middle of November. Total rain in the agronomic year is 578.50 liters. Veraison begins July 20th. The harvest begins on August 15th.

THE VINEYARD: La Sendroseta is a small vineyard of just over one hectare of pink "panal" soil located in the partida de les Sendrosetes in Gandesa. It is a sunny plot facing the Agulles de Bot, the mountain of Santa Bàrbara, and the Orta pass. It is organically and dry farmed.

VARIETY: Garnacha Blanca, planted in the 1990s.

HARVEST DATE: The grapes were hand-harvested on August 13th and 24th, 2022

WINEMAKING: We have revived the ancestral winemaking technique of Terra Alta, known as "brisado" wine. This involves treating white wine as if it were a red wine. The skins, pulp, and seeds are macerated and fermented for 6 days in stainless steel tanks. After pressing, fermentation continues for 20 days in 750-liter ceramic jars. The wine is then aged in the same jars with the lees for 7 months. We use natural yeasts from the grapes.

PRODUCTION: 977 bottles of 0.75 liters
